Mr. Dean provides leadership in developing strategic direction and day-to-day management of information systems and services for Schaller Anderson and all its affiliates. He is responsible for leading the company's Technology organization in integrating information technology into the business strategy, influencing the use of technology to improve business performance, and delivering and supporting needed information and systems across the organization.

Mr. Dean is chair of the Arizona Health-e Connection Roadmap Technical Task Group, launched by Gov. Janet Napolitano in 2005 to develop a plan for early adoption of a statewide electronic health information infrastructure. Mr. Dean also is a member of both the Technical Committee and the RFP Committee for the Delaware Health Information Network, initiated by the Delaware Health Care Commission to create a statewide health information and electronic data interchange network for public and private use.



Before joining Schaller Anderson, Mr. Dean worked at Arthur Andersen for 23 years, rising through the organization to lead its Information Technology department. He also served as managing partner and chief information officer of Andersen Worldwide from 1997 to 1998, and as leader of IT for all of Arthur Andersen from 1998 until 2000.

He also served as senior vice president and chief information officer for United Airlines, and has been involved in consulting and writing in the technology industry.
