Dr. Raghu Santanam is a faculty member in the W. P. Carey School of Business at Arizona State University. He also serves as the Director of Research for the technology research center, Center for Advancing Business through Information Technology (CABIT). His current research focuses on Security and Information Supply Chains, especially in the public health domain. His past research has contributed to Business Process Change, Collaborative Decision-making and Electronic Commerce.

Dr. Santanam has helped a number of organizations on Information Systems and Business Process related changes. He recently worked with the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) and the Maricopa County Department of Public Health (MCDPH) in analyzing process and systems gaps in rolling out a surveillance system, MEDSIS, for the state of Arizona. Dr. Santanam has been a Principal Investigator or Co-Principal Investigator on several projects with Corporations (including Intel, IBM and others) and Government entities (including ADHS, MCDPH, and US Army-ISEC). These projects were mainly concerned with issues of efficiently managing large data/information repositories and retrieving managerially relevant information for decision-making. Dr. Santanam has co-guest edited a special issue of the Journal Decision Support Systems on "Cyberinfrastructure for Homeland Security: Advances in Information Sharing, Data Mining, and Collaboration Systems." He is one of the editors of a Handbook being published by Elsevier entitled, "Handbooks in Information Systems: National Security."

Dr. Santanam has served as the Track Chair for the Americas Conference on Information Systems (AMCIS) on Knowledge Management for 2003, 2004 and 2005. He serves as an Associate Editor for *Information Systems Research*, and *Journal of Electronic Commerce Research*. He has served on the Program Committee for the IEEE Intelligence and Security Informatics (ISI) – 2005 and 2006, INFORMS Conference on Information Systems and Technology – 2004 and 2005, and Workshop on Secure Knowledge Management – 2004. He is one of the advisory editors of the Elsevier series on "Handbooks in Information Systems."

Dr. Santanam has published a number of research articles on Business Process Management, Information Security, Collaborative Decision-making, and Knowledge Management. Dr. Santanam received his B.S. in Electronics and Communications Engineering from the University of Mysore, M.S. in Industrial Management from the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras, and M.S. in Computer Science from SUNY Buffalo. Prior to joining ASU, he was a Mark Woodburn fellow at SUNY Buffalo, where he received his Ph.D. in Management Information Systems.
