Kelly Cronin is director of the Office of Programs and Coordination in the Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology. Ms. Cronin is responsible for efforts related to multi-stakeholder governance, the American Health Information Community and its successor entity. Prior to this assignment, Ms. Cronin was senior advisor to the Administrator of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. In 2004-2005, she led initiatives to incentivize electronic health record adoption in ONC. She also served as the Executive Director of the Council for the Application of Health Information Technology in the Department of Health and Human Services.

Prior to ONC, Ms. Cronin directed patient safety initiatives at the Food and Drug Administration and coordinated the drafting of the Patient Safety and Quality Improvement Act while working for the House Energy and Commerce Health Subcommittee. Her work experience includes health policy analysis, health services research, and clinical trial coordination, on a national and international level. She is a lecturer in the Department of Health Policy at George Washington University and a doctoral candidate in the School of Public Health and Health Services
