Amanda Weaver, M.B.A. has been the Executive Director of the Arizona Osteopathic Medical Association (AOMA) since 1995 representing 1,600 osteopathic physicians and 800 osteopathic medical students. Each year 10 D.O.s and advanced degreed people who work within the osteopathic medical profession are selected to participate in this program. She attributes this training to the increased involvement by both the AOMA and herself in health policy.
